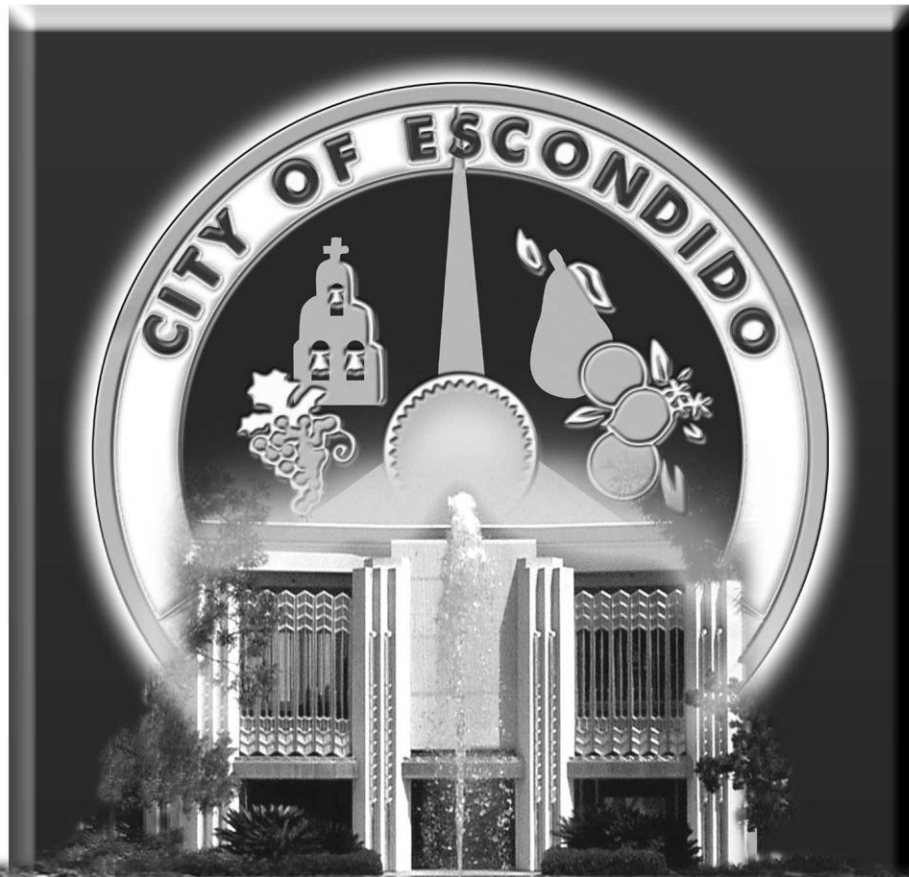

SUBJECT: Certification of November 2012 General Municipal Election Results

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council adopt Resolution No. 2012-187 certifying the November 6 2012, City of Escondido General Municipal Election and declaring the results.

FISCAL ANALYSIS:

Funds for election expenses in the amount of \$155,000 were approved in the FY 2012-13 General Fund budget. Final costs should be available from the Registrar of Voters within the next 60 to 90 days.

BACKGROUND:

On June 20, 2012, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2012-95 calling a General Municipal Election on November 6, 2012, to elect two (2) Council Members with four-year terms and one (1) Treasurer with a four-year term; and to submit to the voters questions relating to the General Plan and the adoption of a proposed Charter by the City. The Council approved Resolution 2012-96 directing preparation of impartial analysis for city measures, authorizing its members to file written arguments in favor of City measures and providing for the filing of rebuttal arguments for City measures.

The Council also adopted Resolution No. 2012-97 requesting the San Diego County Board of Supervisors/Registrar of Voters to consolidate Escondido's Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election.

CONCLUSION:

In accordance with the California Elections Code, certification of the canvass of the returns from the General Municipal Election held on November 6, 2012, is to be presented to Council for action. The official certification from the Registrar of Voters is attached to the resolution as Exhibit "A."

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-187

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF ESCONDIDO, CALIFORNIA,
RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL
MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER
6, 2012, DECLARING THE RESULT AND
SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS REQUIRED BY
LAW

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was conducted in the City of Escondido, on Tuesday, November 6, 2012, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, a notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that candidates were nominated to fill the vacancies as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects said election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in the time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in cities; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2012-95 was adopted June 20, 2012, calling and giving notice of a General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2012-97 was adopted June 20, 2012, requesting the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego and the Registrar of Voters to consolidate a General Municipal Election to be held on November 6, 2012, with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same date; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the California Elections Code §15400, the Official Canvass of the Returns from the General Election held on November 6, 2012, is prepared by the Registrar of Voters and the results are declared by the City Council as to who was elected and as to each measure voted on at the election. The official certification from the Registrar of Voters is attached as Exhibit "A" and is incorporated by this reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Escondido, California, as follows:

SECTION 1. That there were 65 precincts established for the purpose of holding the General Municipal Election in the City of Escondido as established for the holding of state and county elections.

SECTION 2. The General Municipal Election was held for the purpose of submitting to the voters of the City the following questions:

Shall the changes to the City of Escondido's General Plan, approved by the City Council in Resolution 2012-54(R), be adopted?	YES
	NO

Shall the City of Escondido be changed from a general law city to a charter city through the adoption of the charter proposed by Resolution 2012-99(R) of the Escondido City Council?	YES
	NO

SECTION 3. That the regular General Municipal Election was held for the purpose of electing the following officers of the City as required by the laws relating to cities in the State of California, to wit:

- a. Two members of the City Council for the full terms of four (4) years;
- b. One City Treasurer for the full term of four (4) years

SECTION 4. That the number of ballots cast for two Council Members was 64,345; that the whole number of ballots cast in said City for Treasurer was 34,070; that the number of ballots cast for Proposition N was 36,881; and the number of ballots cast for Proposition P was 37,353.

SECTION 5. That the names of persons voted for at said election were as follows:

SECTION 6. The City Council, pursuant to Exhibit "A," does hereby declare and determine that:

- a. Olga Diaz was re-elected as a member of the City Council of said City for the full term of four (4) years;
- b. Michael Morasco was elected as a member of the City Council of said City for the full term of four (4) years;
- c. Kenneth C. Hugins was re-elected City Treasurer of said City for the full term of four (4) years;
- d. Proposition "N" (General Plan) passed by a majority of the vote; and
- e. Proposition "P" (Charter City Proposal) did not pass with a majority of the vote.

SECTION 7. That the City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of said City a statement of the results of said election, showing:

- a. The whole number of votes cast in the City;
- b. The names of the persons voted for;
- c. The ballot language of both propositions; and
- d. The number of votes cast for each proposition.

SECTION 8. That the City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of such persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and duly

authenticated; that the City Clerk shall cause to be administered to each person elected, the Oath of Office prescribed in the State Constitution of the State of California, and shall have them subscribe thereto and file the same in the office of the City Clerk. Whereupon each and all of said persons so elected shall be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

SECTION 9. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of the resolution; shall enter the same in the book of original resolutions of said City; and shall make a minute entry of the passage and adoption thereof in the records of the proceedings of the City Council of said City, in the minutes of the meeting at which the same is passed and adopted.

SUBJECT: City Council Vacancy

RECOMMENDATION:

Consider and take action on the procedures related to the appointment or make such appointment.

FISCAL ANALYSIS:

Approximately \$500-\$1,000 to cover costs associated with advertisements and miscellaneous expenses. Costs will be covered from the 2012 election budget.

BACKGROUND:

In the regular municipal election on November 6, 2012, Council member Marie Waldron was elected to the California State Legislature. She will be sworn into that office on December 3, 2012, and will have resigned from her Council office. Her resignation will create a vacancy in that office, which has two years remaining on the term. The City Council has had vacancies in 1998 and 2010, choosing both times to follow state law and make an appointment to the vacant position for the remainder of the term.

Applicable Law

A vacancy in an elective office can occur in a number of ways, including resignation. The resignation takes effect by its terms. It need not be "accepted" by anyone to be effective.

The California Government Code provides the required steps that must be taken when a vacancy occurs. Within 60 days of a vacancy, the City Council must fill the vacancy by appointment or by calling a special election, to be held on the next established election date not later than 114 days thereafter. Gov't Code section 36512; 34902(a). The successor serves from the date of appointment (or the Tuesday following the election, if an election is held) until the expiration of the predecessor's term.

In general law cities, the City Council has broad discretion to choose the method for filling the vacancy. Section 36512 does not contain a detailed process, but instead gives the City Council discretion to choose either appointment or special election, and provides a 60-day deadline for making that decision from the time of the vacancy. Section 36512 also specifies that if a special election is chosen, the special election must be held not less than 114 days from the call for the special election.

In the present case, the vacancy is anticipated to occur no later than December 3, 2012, at the time Council member Waldron is sworn in as a member of the California State Legislature. Thus, the City Council will have 60 days from the date of the resignation to make an appointment or adopt the necessary resolutions to call for a special election.

Eligibility

In order to be eligible to hold a municipal office, a person must be a resident of the city and a registered voter of the city at the time nomination papers are issued. Gov't Code sections 34882, 34904.

Process

Most cities fill mayoral and city council vacancies by appointment, rather than special election. This is due to the high cost of holding a special election.¹ In those cities using an appointment process, the most common practice is to direct the City Clerk to put out an announcement to the public that the position will be filled by appointment, and inviting interested persons to apply for the position.

On Sunday, November 18 and 25, 2012, the City Clerk published a notice of the vacancy and invited interested persons to apply by completing an application and providing answers to a supplemental questionnaire. This notice was published in the Union Tribune and placed on the local government channel 19. It was also announced at the November 14, 2012 City Council meeting. The application form and the invitation to apply was placed on the City's website on Monday, November 19, 2012 at www.escondido.org.

Applicants were advised to submit all information no later than Monday, December 3, 2012 by 3:30 p.m. to enable the City Council to have time to consider the materials prior to December 12, 2012.

As a result of this process, applications and supporting material have been received and all materials have been placed in the City Clerk's office for public inspection, and copies made available to all Council members.

¹ For example, the Registrar of Voters provided Poway (population approximately 50,000 with 29,000 registered voters) an estimate of approximately \$250,000 for a special election. Our City Clerk has indicated that Registrar estimates for a similar election in Escondido would be \$465,000 to \$485,000.

Voting Requirements

The Escondido Municipal Code does not have specific voting requirements for City Council decisions. Thus, state law applies and the City Council may generally take action by a vote of a majority of a quorum (Civil Code section 12, Code of Civil Procedure section 15). In the unlikely event the City Council wishes to adopt an ordinance or resolution, three votes will be required pursuant to Government Code section 36936 (requiring a majority vote of the total membership of the city council for resolutions, orders for the payment of money, and ordinances).

It should be noted that the Brown Act does not allow for the City Council to hold a closed session on the subject of filling a Mayor or City Council vacancy. Although closed sessions are allowed for the appointment or evaluation of a public employee pursuant to Gov't Code section 54957, "employee" does not include an elected official or member of the legislative body. Gov't Code section 54957.

Additionally, when the public action on filling the vacancy is taken, it should be noted that the Brown Act also prohibits the use of secret ballots. Gov't Code section 54953(a).
